Pastor's Article:

One of the hallmarks of the United Methodist Church is the itinerancy. This comes from the church's beginnings with circuit riders. These horseback riding preachers traveled from church to church in the wilderness to preach the gospel sent by Bishops who appointed them to their circuits. Today, pastors in local churches continue to be appointed by Bishops and are moved from church to church. The average stay for most preachers is about six years. The advantage of this system is that we all remember that it is God's church and not ours—not the preacher's own "kingdom." Preachers are workers in the God's vineyard.

This year is the end of my sixth year as Pastor of Hoover First UMC and at the end of June, I will receive an appointment to a new church as Hoover First receives a new pastor. I am going to Pleasant Grove United Methodist Church north of Hueytown.

Hoover First will welcome Angela Teal as your new pastor. With the change in pastors, there is always a transition. Your new pastor will bring gifts and graces and skills that will strengthen and grow Hoover First. In the coming weeks, you will learn more about her. The Staff Parish Committee will guide this process.

Financial Update

Hoover First UMC is always the Little Church Who Could. Despite the fact that we lost the income we were receiving for having a cell tower, Hoover First finished 2016 with only a small shortfall in meeting our expenses. This was covered by reserves we had built up from previous years. As we begin 2017, we are projecting that there could be a deficit of as much as \$30,000 in our income to expenses. Believing that God is at work in our congregation and that we will continue to grow in grace, we do not want to cut any of our budgeted expenses where are already at a "bare bones" level. We have a building that requires upkeep and a staff that we value. Our programs are vital to our life as a congregation. A few years ago, Hoover First was blessed to receive a bequest from Patsy Hunt, a life-long member. For the coming year, the Finance Committee has decided to use some of that large gift to cover our expenses. We know God is growing our congregation, we will grow our income from other sources. Hoover First is a vital congregation who is moving through a period of transition. By the end of 2017, our goal is to grow our church so that we will not have to rely on our reserves. As a part of this congregation, we know that you will prayerfully consider what God is calling you to do to achieve this goal.
